The new contract valued at 22million is with Kier who will be tasked to catch up with backlog of work. Contracts are let on basis of EU regulations.

A resident made suggestions with regard to work that could be done at the Tan Pit including litter clearance.

The corner by village hall is dangerous and it was suggested that the village request a permissive path to rear of village hall. Cllr Parker will pursue this with the resident & the landowner.
