- a) The audit report from 2023-24 and 2024-25 confirmed the Council's financial and governance position is good.

APM6/25 Issues raised by the meeting:

A resident raised the issue speeding through Burlton and asked that the Parish Council consider supporting a reduction of speed limit to 30mph; and Safer Neighbourhoods Team speed monitoring.

A change of speed limit is a lengthy & costly legal process. The Local Highway Authority has assessed and deemed 40mph the appropriate speed for the road. The Parish Council has done all in its power to address speeding issues in the Parish.

The railings at the War Memorial need repainting and more substantial repairs to the base.
